- Healthy snacks are provided as part of the programme and may include; fruit, snack bars, yoghurt and sandwiches. If your child has any allergies that were not listed on the registration form, please advise the team leader.
- If your child is going to be absent please call or text the Team Leader or Sport Canterbury on 373 5060 that morning to advise them.
- The staff to child ratio is 1:10. At least one staff member will hold current first aid certificate.
- A Policy & Procedure manual is available at the venue for you to view.
- For urgent messages concerning your child, please contact the Team Leader or call Sport Canterbury.
- If you have any issues relating to who is allowed to pick up your child, please let the Team Leader know.
- Medical & Health conditions are to be detailed in the registration form. If medicine is to be administered, a consent form will need to be signed, and all details supplied.
- Sick children are asked, out of consideration, to be kept at home. If a child falls sick at the venue the Team Leader will assess the situation, and if deemed appropriate, will contact parents/caregiver to collect the child.
- Disciplinary Procedure– Bad behavior will not be accepted on this programme. If the child's behavior is a problem after warnings from the Team Leader, parents will be contacted to collect them. In this situation a refund will not be given.
- Complaint Forms are available at the venue.
- Child Safety & Protection is vital and any suspicion of any form of child abuse will be reported to Child Youth & Family.
