GRx - Referral Guidelines

To enable us to provide the best possible service for your patients please ensure the following when you refer a patient to Green Prescription:

- 1. Adult, 18 years or older.
- 2. You consider their health condition(s) stable enough for participation in low to moderate intensity physical activity.
- 3. Your patient is currently inactive (doing less than a total of 2.5 hours physical activity per week) but is ready to be more active.
- 4. Your patient understands what GRx is and gives their consent to being referred.
- 5. If required, your patient has access to appropriate people that can provide one-on-one support (i.e. physical or mental disability, language barrier).

If your patient is already regularly active, direct them to www.activecanterbury.org.nz for new physical activity ideas.

The table below shows the nominated allied health professionals given prescribing rights based on the Green Prescription Contract Holder guidelines Ministry of Health 2010.
